
FINAL AWARD

IT IS ORDERED that the final award entered herein on April 15, 1965, be vacated.

IN COMPLIANCE with the decision of the Court of Claims in the subject case, Citizen Band of Potawatomi Indians v. United States, 179 Ct. Cl. 473, 391 F.2d 614 (1967), cert. denied, 389 U.S. 1046, 390 U.S. 957 (1968), and further upon consideration of findings of fact 1 through 86, previously entered herein, and the Commission's findings of fact 87 through 111 and the opinion this date filed herein, all of which are made a part of this order, the Commission concludes as a matter of law that the plaintiffs herein are entitled to recover from the defendant, for and on behalf of the Potawatomi Tribe or Nation as it existed between 1795 and 1833, the amount of \$4,480,510.26, less the amount of \$364,901.00, representing the consideration paid by the United States for the 1829 cession of the subject lands, and less the amount of \$10,790.28, representing allowable gratuitous offests, leaving a net balance of \$4,104,818.98.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED by the Commission that the plaintiffs, on behalf of the Potawatomi Tribe or Nation, as it existed between 1795 and 1833, shall have and recover of and from the defendant the sum of \$4,104,818.98, which sum is in full satisfaction of all claims in Docket Nos. 217, 15-K, and 29-J.
