FINAL AWARD

An interlocutory order was entered herein on March 15, 1972, 27 Ind. Cl. Comm. 98, 131, amended July 26, 1972, 28 Ind. Cl. Comm. 251, 254, awarding the plaintiffs the sum of \$80,585.76, less allowable offsets, as additional compensation for the land ceded to the United States by the plaintiffs under the Treaty of August 30, 1831, 7 Stat. 359. The Commission further ordered that this case proceed for the purpose of determining the gratuitous offsets, if any, allowable under Section 2 of the Indian Claims Commission Act.

On March 26, 1973, a hearing was had before the Commission wherein the defendant presented claims in the total amount of \$24,871.56, as additional payments on the claim or as gratuitous payments in this docket and in Docket 304. The parties thereupon agreed and stipulated in open hearing before the Commission that \$17,950.00 of the amount claimed was in fact paid by the defendant and receipt thereof acknowledged by the plaintiffs. The parties further agreed that the sum of \$17,950.00 be credited against the award heretofore made in Docket 304 and that any and all further additional claims for offsets in this docket and Docket 304 were withdrawn by the defendant.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that the agreement of the parties that \$17,950.00 paid by the defendant to the plaintiffs under the Treaty of February 18, 1833, is additional compensation for land ceded by the plaintiffs in the Treaty of August 30, 1831, and that all further and additional claims for legal and gratuitous offsets in Docket 304 and Docket 305 be withdrawn, is approved.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that as a final award the plaintiffs have and recover from the defendant the sum of \$80,585.76 in full satisfaction of all claims presented in Docket 305.
