ORDER GRANTING DEFENDANT'S MOTION FOR ENTRY OF FINAL JUDGMENT

On June 21, 1973, the Commission issued its findings of fact, opinion, and interlocutory order in the above-captioned matter awarding to the plaintiffs the sum of \$1,843,038.50 plus an additional amount upon the principal sum of \$410,921.12 measured by simple interest at the rate of 5 percent per annum from March 31, 1973, until paid, less such offsets, if any, as may be allowable under the Indian Claims Commission Act (30 Ind. Cl. Comm. 437). On July 18, 1973, the defendant filed a "Motion for Entry of Final Judgment", on the grounds that "the United States will assert no offsets in this docket". The defendant further advised the Commission in its motion that "Counsel for the plaintiffs have authorized the Government to state that plaintiffs have no objection to the granting of this motion". By a letter dated July 23, 1973, and addressed to this Commission, which letter is hereby made a part of the record, counsel for the plaintiffs advised that the plaintiffs have no objection to the Commission granting the Government's motion of July 18, 1973, and entering final judgment.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that as of the date of this order, the Commission's "Interlocutory Order" of June 21, 1973, in this docket, be, and the same in all respects is hereby, entered as a final award wherein the plaintiffs shall have and recover from the defendant the sum of \$1,843,038.50, plus an additional amount upon the principal sum of \$410,931.12 measured by simple interest at the rate of 5 percent per annum from March 31, 1973, until paid.
