FINAL AWARD

UPON JOINT MOTION FOR ENTRY OF FINAL JUDGMENT filed by the parties herein on September 7, 1973, pursuant to a Stipulation for Entry of Final Judgment filed with said motion, the Commission considered the evidence presented, both oral and written, at a hearing called for that purpose on September 12, 1973.
