ORDER ALLOWING ATTORNEYS' FEE AND DIRECTING FILING  
FOR REIMBURSEMENT OF ATTORNEYS' EXPENSES

UPON CONSIDERATION of the petition of the Attorney of Record for the above-named plaintiffs, Rodney J. Edwards, for allowance of attorneys' fee in Docket No. 189, filed on January 30, 1974, and in accordance with the findings of the Commission filed herewith, the Commission concludes that the attorneys for the plaintiffs herein are entitled to an attorneys' fee in the amount of \$185,930.68 for services rendered in the prosecution of plaintiffs' claim in Docket 189, and that the payment of this amount to Rodney J. Edwards, Attorney of Record, out of the funds appropriated to pay the award herein, for distribution by him to those entitled to participate in the sharing of the fee in accordance with their respective interests therein, will represent payment in full of all claims for legal services rendered in this docket.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that out of the funds appropriated to pay the final judgment entered herein on August 9, 1973, in favor of the plaintiffs (31 Ind. Cl. Comm. 87) there shall be disbursed to Rodney J. Edwards, Attorney of Record, as payment in full of all claims for legal services rendered in connection with the prosecution of this case, the sum of \$185,930.68, for distribution by him of the amount due to each of those entitled to participate in the sharing of the fee.




