

ORDER DENYING PLAINTIFF'S MOTION TO PERMIT INSPECTION

On July 24, 1972, the plaintiff filed a motion requesting an order from the Commission to permit the plaintiff to examine defendant's appraisal report of the subject lands ceded under the Treaty of January 31, 1855, 12 Stat. 939. Since the parties have now stipulated the 1855 fair market value of the subject lands, plaintiff's motion is moot.


IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that plaintiff's motion to permit inspection be, and the same is hereby, denied.
