

ORDER ALLOWING ATTORNEYS' FEE


HAVING CONSIDERED the petition for attorneys' fee filed in this docket on March 11, 1974, by James R. Fitzharris, attorney of record for plaintiff herein, and in accordance with the Commission's findings of fact filed herewith, the Commission concludes that the attorneys for plaintiffs have earned and are entitled to an attorneys' fee for services rendered in the prosecution of the plaintiffs claim in this docket in the amount of \$811,760.80, and payment of this amount to James R. Fitzharris out of the funds heretofore appropriated to pay the award herein, for distribution by him to those entitled to participate in the sharing of the fee in accordance with their respective interest therein, will represent payment in full of all claims for legal services rendered by said attorneys to the plaintiffs in Docket 57.


IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that out of the funds appropriated to pay the final award heretofore entered herein, there shall be disbursed to James R. Fitzharris, the attorney of record for plaintiffs, as payment in full for all legal services rendered to the plaintiff in the prosecution of all claims in Docket 57, the sum of \$811,760.80, for distribution by him to those entitled to share in such attorneys' fee with their respective interest therein.


