INTERLOCUTORY ORDER

On April 24, 1970, plaintiff filed twenty-one amended exceptions to the General Accounting Office report, certified on April 26, 1957, submitted by defendant in response to plaintiff's petition for an accounting of plaintiff's funds. The Commission, by order dated August 6, 1971, granted in part plaintiff's motion to file amended exceptions.

UPON CONSIDERATION of plaintiff's motion for an order fixing time for defendant to furnish data and for rulings on issues of law, filed on November 17, 1971, and of defendant's motion for partial summary judgment, filed on October 23, 1973, and the various pleadings in response thereto filed by the parties; and being fully informed in the premises; and for the reasons set forth in our opinion this date entered herein,

IT IS ORDERED that plaintiff's amended exceptions 6, 13 and 14 to defendant's accounting report in this docket be, and are hereby, dismissed.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the parties meet with Commissioner Vance on Monday, August 12, 1974, at 10:00 a.m. in the hearing room of the Commission to discuss what further information should be supplied by defendant, and in what form, as to exceptions 2, 3 and 5.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that defendant file with the Commission and serve on plaintiff the supplemental accounts required by the accompanying opinion as to exceptions 16, 19 and 21 on or before September 9, 1974.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that plaintiff file, on or before August 9, 1974, its exceptions, if any, to certain data submitted by defendant on July 12, 1972, in response to plaintiff's exception 7.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that said case be set for trial as to exceptions 10, 11, 12, 17, 18 and 20-D, on Thursday, September 12, 1974, at 10:00 a.m. in the hearing room of the Commission.
