ORDER ALLOWING ADDITIONAL REIMBURSABLE EXPENSES

HAVING CONSIDERED the supplemental petition filed by Lawrence C. Mills, Esq., attorney of record for the Sac and Fox Tribe of the Mississippi in Iowa, on behalf of the law firm of Mills and Garrett, for reimbursement of additional expenses, the Commission concludes the law firm of Mills and Garrett is entitled to receive the sum of \$5,840.35, out of the award heretofore appropriated herein, as payment for the additional unreimbursed expenses incurred. The payment of this sum, in addition to the sum of \$3,338.09, previously allowed for expenses, will represent payment in full for all reimbursable expenses incurred by the law firm of Mills and Garrett herein.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that out of the funds heretofore appropriated to pay the final award in this case, there shall be disbursed to Lawrence C. Mills, Esq., the sum of \$5,840.35 on behalf of the law firm of Mills and Garrett, which sum, together with the sum of \$3,338.09 previously disbursed to said law firm

for reimbursement for expenses, shall constitute full reimbursement to said law firm of allowable expenses incurred in the prosecution of this case.
