ORDER GRANTING DEFENDANT'S MOTION FOR TRIAL IN

IT APPEARING TO THE COMMISSION that the parties concur in each other's motions, and that the separate trials and continuance are necessary,

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that said motions be, and the same hereby are, granted, and that a hearing before this Commission on the defendant's liability, if any, for an alleged oral promise to supply the plaintiff with fishing gear and other equipment, hereby is scheduled for Tuesday, October 15, 1974, at 10:00 a.m. in the hearing room of the Commission.
