INTERLOCUTORY ORDER

UPON CONSIDERATION of plaintiffs' motion for a complete and proper accounting, filed December 3, 1970, and defendant's opposition thereto, filed February 23, 1971, and recognizing that the plaintiffs herein adopted the briefing and argument of the Te-Moak Bands of Western Shoshone Indians of Nevada, plaintiff in Docket 326-A, on the question of the duty of the defendant to make funds held in trust for the plaintiffs productive of income, and the Commission having decided said question in an opinion dated October 4, 1973 (31 Ind. Cl. Comm. 427),


IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the aforesaid opinion in Docket 326-A shall constitute the law of this case insofar as it applies to the fund known as "Indian Moneys, Proceeds of Labor."


IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that plaintiffs' motion for a complete accounting be granted as to exceptions numbered 7, 8, 10 and 13, and denied as to exceptions numbered 1 through 6, 9, 11, 12, and 14 through 17.


IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the attorneys and accountants for the parties appear for an informal conference before Commissioner Blue in the hearing room of the Commission at 10:15 a.m. on Friday, September 6, 1974. To be discussed at this conference is the form and manner in which the additional information required by exceptions 7 and 8 should be compiled, and what would be a reasonable time for completion of the supplemental accounting. The attorneys and accountants for each party should familiarize themselves with all aspects of the accounting phase of this case, and be prepared to discuss alternative methods of deriving the required accounting information.


