ORDER MODIFYING PREVIOUS ORDER AND FOR SUPPLEMENTAL ACCOUNTING

UPON CONSIDERATION of defendant's motions of August 23, 1973, for partial summary judgment, and for rehearing and clarification, of our opinion and order issued on July 25, 1973, 31 Ind. Cl. Comm. 40, in these cases, and plaintiff's responses thereto and defendant's replies, and being fully informed in the premises, and for the reasons set forth in our opinion this date entered herein;

IT IS ORDERED that our order of July 25, 1973, be, and hereby is, modified as to exceptions (a) and (b) as concerns tribal organization funds or enterprises managed by plaintiff, in accordance with the accompanying opinion; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that defendant's respective motions as to an accounting beyond August 13, 1946, and as to summary judgment concerning various natural resources, be, and hereby are, denied without prejudice; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that defendant's respective motions in all other respects be, and hereby are, denied; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that defendant submit, on or before September 30, 1974, a supplemental accounting showing the dates on which control over specific tribal organization funds or enterprises were transferred to plaintiff, and the claimed authority for the transfer.
