ORDER RELIEVING DEFENDANT OF REQUIREMENT OF SUPPLEMENTING ITS ACCOUNTING AS TO CERTAIN MATTERS

At the informal conference held herein on September 6, 1974, the attorney for the plaintiffs notified the Commission that the plaintiffs would waive the supplemental accounting required of the defendant by our interlocutory order of August 14, 1974 (34 Ind. Cl. Comm. 414, 426), as to exceptions numbered 7 and 8, and to all of exception 10, except for those items described as railroad rights of way for which \$6,896.55 was deposited into the fund captioned "Indian Moneys, Proceeds of Labor, Nevada Indians, Nevada" (GAO Report, p. 31), and the amounts \$676.67 and \$1,163.20, deposited into the fund captioned "Indian Moneys, Proceeds of Labor, Pyramid Lake Indians, Nevada" (GAO Report, p. 72). The aforesaid being accepted by the defendant, and the supplemental accounting not otherwise deemed necessary by this Commission,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the defendant be, and it hereby is, relieved of the requirement imposed by our order of August 14, 1974, of supplementing the accounting report filed herein as to exceptions numbered 7 and 8, and as to exception number 10, except for the items mentioned above.
