INTERLOCUTORY ORDER

On May 15, 1970, plaintiff filed seventeen amended exceptions to the General Accounting Office report, certified on September 6, 1960, submitted by defendant in response to plaintiff's petition for an accounting of plaintiff's funds. The Commission, by order dated August 6, 1971, granted in part plaintiff's motion to file amended exceptions.



IT IS ORDERED that plaintiff's amended exceptions 6, 7, 13 and 17 to defendant's accounting report in this docket be, and are hereby, dismissed.






