ORDER DENYING PLAINTIFF'S MOTION FOR LEAVE TO AMEND ITS PETITION

On July 1, 1974, plaintiff filed a motion for leave to amend its petition in Docket 69 by adding thereto a request for supplementation of defendant's accounting report and to amend its petitions in Dockets 69, 299 and 353 by including therein a request that defendant be ordered to extend its accounting report from August 13, 1946, to date.

For the reasons stated in the accompanying opinion,


IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that plaintiff's motion to amend Docket 69 as aforesaid be, and hereby is, denied; and that plaintiff's motion in Dockets 69, 299 and 353 to extend defendant's accounting beyond August 13, 1946, be denied without prejudice.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that plaintiff have until February 19, 1975, to file any amended or supplemental exceptions, or motions for supplemental accounting, to defendant's 1961 accounting report.




