

ORDER ALLOWING ATTORNEYS' FEE


UPON CONSIDERATION of the application of Charles A. Hobbs, attorney of record for the plaintiff herein, on behalf of the law firm of Wilkinson, Cragun and Barker, for allowance of attorneys' fee, and in accordance with the findings of fact filed concurrently herewith, the Commission concludes that the law firm of Wilkinson, Cragun and Barker is entitled to receive from the amount of the award heretofore made to the plaintiffs, the sum of \$880,905.70, plus 10 percent of the interest payable pursuant to the terms of such award through the date of appropriation, June 12, 1975, Public Law 94-32.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that out of the funds to be appropriated to pay the final award to the plaintiff herein, there be disbursed to the law firm of Wilkinson, Cragun and Barker the sum of \$880,905.70, plus 10 percent of any interest determined to be payable pursuant to the award.
