ORDER ALLOWING ATTORNEYS' FEE

UPON CONSIDERATION of the petition of Charles A. Hobbs, attorney of record for the plaintiff, for award of attorneys' fee in the above-captioned docket, filed on May 17, 1976, and in accordance with the findings of fact entered herewith,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the contract attorneys in the above-captioned docket, the law firm of Wilkinson, Cragun & Barker, be awarded as attorneys' fee for all services rendered by said contract attorneys in said docket, the amount of \$320,000.00.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that out of the funds appropriated pursuant to Public Law 94-303, June 1, 1976, to pay the final award entered herein on March 17, 1976, in favor of the plaintiff, there shall be disbursed to Charles A. Hobbs, attorney of record, on behalf of the contract attorneys, the firm of Wilkinson, Cragun & Barker, the amount of \$320,000.00, which represents ten percent (10%) of the final award. This amount represents payment in full for all services rendered in the prosecution of this case.
