
ORDER DENYING MOTION FOR RECONSIDERATION AND HEARING


Upon consideration of the foregoing, the Commission concludes the motion is without merit, and it should be denied.


IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the motion for reconsideration and hearing be, and the same hereby is, denied.
