ORDER ALLOWING ATTORNEYS' FEE

UPON CONSIDERATION of the joint petition of James R. Fitzharris and Jack Joseph, attorneys of record for the plaintiffs in Docket 64 and Dockets 335 and 338, respectively, for allowance of attorneys' fee, and in accordance with the findings of fact filed concurrently and hereby made a part of this order, the Commission concludes that James R. Fitzharris and Jack Joseph are each entitled to receive from the amount of the award heretofore made to such plaintiffs, the sum of \$87,257.34, or a gross amount of \$174,514.68, which is ten per cent of the final award entered herein.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that out of funds appropriated to pay the final award, there should be distributed to James R. Fitzharris and Jack Joseph, the sum of \$174,514.68, in equal shares of \$87,257.34, for distribution by them to such attorneys, representatives and legal firms entitled to share in the fee in accord with their respective interests therein. Payment of the sum of \$174,514.68 shall be in full satisfaction for all legal services rendered in the prosecution of these claims.
