
FINAL AWARD

Upon plaintiffs' motion of June 1, 1978, for entry of final award, to which motion no objections have been filed, and defendant having waived its right to claim gratuitous offsets chargeable against the interlocutory award previously entered herein,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that, as a final award in full satisfaction of all claims against the defendant in Docket 59, plaintiffs do have and recover from the defendant on behalf of Saginaw Chippewa Band of Indians as constituted in 1808, the sum of three million four hundred seventy-nine thousand three hundred eight dollars (\$3,479,308.00).
