FINAL AWARD

Upon the findings of fact numbered 1 through 47, heretofore entered in the case at bar, the opinions issued concurrently with said findings of fact, the additional finding of fact numbered 48 and the opinion this date issued herein, all of which are incorporated in this final award, the Commission concludes as a matter of law that:
