ORDER ALLOWING ATTORNEYS' FEE

UPON CONSIDERATION of the petition of the attorney of record for the above-named plaintiffs, Rodney J. Edwards, attorney of record, as payment in full of all claims for legal services rendered in connection with the prosecution of this

case, the sum of \$262,117.45 for distribution by him of the amount due to each of the participating attorneys or teste legal representatives.
