ORDER CERTIFYING AND TRANSFERRING CASES TO
THE UNITED STATES COURT OF CLAIMS


On August 30, 1978, the Commission entered an order in Dockets 352 and 369 finally severing from Docket 369 the claim of the Aleut Community of St. George Island [which had been tried with an identical claim arising from breach of fair and honorable dealings in Docket 352], designating this claim Docket 369-A, and consolidating it with Docket 352 for the purpose of entering final judgment in said dockets (42 Ind. Cl. Comm. 526-528). On the same date a final judgment, subject to appeal, was entered in

Dockets 352 and 369-A (42 Ind. Cl. Comm. 529). Claims arising from breaches of fair and honorable dealings allegedly remaining in Docket 369 have yet to be tried. There being no time remaining to it to complete the adjudication of all matters involved in the above-captioned cases, the Commission, pursuant to Public Law 94-465, approved October 8, 1976 (90 Stat. 1990),

ORDERS that these cases be, and they hereby are, certified and transferred to the United States Court of Claims, and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Clerk of the Commission shall place in the file of each of the above-captioned cases the docket book entries pertaining thereto and a copy of this order, and file a copy of this order with the Clerk of the United States Court of Claims.


